Thanksgiving dinner box sign-ups now in progress til Nov. 23rd

PRESCOTT VALLEY (and down to Cordes Jct.) — Sign-ups for Thanksgiving Dinner Boxes started November 1, and will continue until November 23.

People living in Prescott Valley and surrounding vicinities should sign up at Yavapai Food Bank (YFB), 8866 E. Long Mesa Dr. in Prescott Valley, phone 775-5255.

Individuals that normally get their regular food boxes from St. Vincent dePaul in Cordes Junction, will sign up there for their Thanksgiving dinner box, but all others should sign up at YFB. All sign-ups at either location will get a numbered slip to take to Living Faith Christian Center (LFCC), 7225 Coyote Springs Rd. on November 22 and 23 from 1-6 p.m to pick up their turkey and all the trimmings. Coats and blankets will also be available to those that need them.

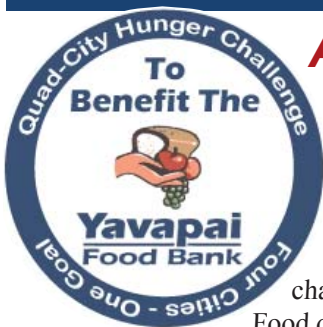
PRESCOTT — Sign-ups in Prescott are at the First Baptist Church at 145 Marina St. They started signing up November 1, Monday-Friday from 9:30-3. Boxes will be given out November 22-23, also from 9:30-3. Please no phone calls.

CHINO VALLEY — For people that usually go to the Chino Valley food bank for their regular food boxes, please call 636-8478 to find out dates and times for holiday programs.

OTHER AGENCIES AND OUTLYING AREAS — Food for many other agencies and outlying areas will be provided through Yavapai Food Bank. Wherever you pick up your regular food box is where you will get your Thanksgiving Dinner Box, including a turkey. Check with the agency in your area for more information.
